6. What did the Devil promise to give Jesus if he worshiped him?
7. What did Jesus say we should do instead of worshiping the Devil?
8. Where did the Devil take Jesus for the third test?
9. What did the Devil tell Jesus to do at the Temple?
10. How did Jesus answer the third temptation?
11. What did the Devil do after he finished tempting Jesus?

Application Questions

1. When is a time you wanted to do something wrong but said no?
2. How do you feel when you make a good choice?
3. Why do you think it is important to remember God's word?
4. Who can help you when you feel tempted?
5. What is one way you can trust God this week?

Theological Insights

1. Jesus is both fully God and fully human.
2. Jesus was tempted like we are, but he did not sin.
3. God's word is strong and can help us make good choices.
4. The Devil is real, but God is stronger.
5. We should worship and trust God alone.
