Comprehension Questions

1. Who was Jesus talking to in this passage?
2. What did Jesus say about people who are poor?
3. What will happen to people who are hungry now?
4. What did Jesus say about people who cry now?
5. How are people blessed when others hate them for following Jesus?
6. What kind of reward does God give in heaven?
7. What warning did Jesus give to rich people?
8. What will happen to people who laugh now, but do not follow God?
9. Why is it not always good when everyone speaks well of you?

Application Questions

1. When do you feel close to God, even if life is hard?
2. Why do you think Jesus says people can be blessed when they are sad or hungry?
3. What are some things people think will make them blessed?
4. How can we trust God more than money or things?
5. What is one way you can follow Jesus this week, even if it is hard?

Theological Insights

1. God blesses people who trust him, even when life is hard.
2. Being poor or sad does not mean God has forgotten you.
3. True blessing is knowing God and being part of his kingdom.
4. We should not trust in money, popularity, or comfort.
5. Jesus blesses those who follow him, even when others do not understand.
