Read Luke 11:14-23

Comprehension Questions

1. What happened to the man when Jesus made the demon leave?
2. How did the people feel when they saw this happen?
3. What did some people say about where Jesus got his power?
4. What did other people ask Jesus to do?
5. How did Jesus answer their thoughts about a divided house or kingdom?
6. Who did Jesus say gives him the power to drive out demons?
7. What did Jesus say about a strong man guarding his house?
8. What happens when a stronger man comes?
9. What did Jesus say about being with him or against him?

Application Questions

1. Do you believe that good is stronger than evil? Why or why not?
2. Why do you think some people did not believe in Jesus' power?
3. How can we choose to be on God's side today?
4. What does it mean to trust Jesus when bad things happen in life?

Theological Insights

1. Jesus has real power over evil spirits and bad things.
2. God's power is stronger than any other power.
3. People cannot stay in the middle; they must choose to be with Jesus or not.
4. The Kingdom of God began when Jesus came to earth.
5. Jesus invites us to be part of God's family by trusting him.
