5. **expert**: A person who knows a lot about a subject.
6. **felt sorry for**: To have felt sad for someone because they were hurt or in trouble.
7. **inn**: A simple hotel where travelers stay.
8. **law**: A set of rules that people must obey.
9. **Levite**: A person from the tribe of Levi who helped in the Temple.
10. **neighbor**: 1. A person who lives near you. 2. Any person who needs our help and love.
11. **olive oil**: A smooth liquid made from pressing olives that is used for cooking or for burning in lamps.
12. **pay back**: To give money back to someone because you owed it to them.
13. **priest**: A man who did special work for God in the Temple.
14. **robber**: A person who steals.
15. **Samaritan**: A person from the region of Samaria.
16. **soul**: The part of a person that lives forever and is not the body.
