4. **peace** (noun): A quiet, calm feeling with no war or fighting.
5. **poor** (adjective): Having very little money or food.
6. **proverb** (noun): A short, famous saying that gives good advice.
7. **rich** (adjective): Having a lot of money or valuable things.
8. **truth** (noun): That which is real, correct, and not false.
9. **wisdom** (noun): Knowing what is right and making good choices.
10. **wise** (adjective): Smart because of knowing what is right and making good choices.
